## **Table of Weights and Measures**

For those persons who have neither scales nor weights *Mrs. Chadwick's Home Cookery*, 1853

1 lb of wheat flour = 1 quart 1 lb. 2 oz of Indian meal = 1 quart 1 lb butter when soft = 1 quart 1 lb of broken loaf sugar, broken up = 1 quart 1 lb 1 oz powdered loaf sugar = 1 quart 1 lb 1 oz best brown sugar = 1 quart = 1 pound10 eggs 1 tablespoon = 1 oz16 large tablespoonfuls  $= \frac{1}{2}$  pint 8 large tablespoonfuls = 1 gill4 large tablespoonfuls = ½ gill 12 drops thin liquid = 1 tsp1 gallon = 8 pints1 pint = 16 oz= 8 drachms 1 oz A common tumbler  $= \frac{1}{2}$  pint or 8 oz A common wineglass (not a modern wineglass)  $= \frac{1}{2}$  gill or 4 large tablespoons

4 wineglasses (not a modern wineglass) =  $\frac{1}{2}$  pint or 8 oz

Common teacup = 6 oz

## **Dry Measure**

Half a gallon = \frac{1}{4} \text{ peck}

One gallon = \frac{1}{2} \text{ peck}

Two gallon = \text{one peck}

Four gallons = \text{half a bushel}

Eight gallons = \text{one bushel}
