Susan A. Cavender, getting paid for knitting 32 pairs of socks at \$1.50 per pair, March 19, 1863, in San Antonio. Total: \$48.00. Doesn't say how long that took her.

At Huntsville, Jane B. Cotton made 100 shirts for \$75.00 and 80 pairs of drawers for \$40.00, March 31, 1863.
